This exquisite Aston Martin DB6 was first delivered in late 1966 through the then-dealer H.R. Owen in London and registered on March 14, 1967. The first owner drove the car for only 12,067 miles and sold it to Edinburgh in 1970. It had several subsequent owners in England before the vehicle found its way to Germany via an auction in 1996. A large number of invoices for repairs and services from this period are available. A valuation report from the year 2000 rated the vehicle as above average, and in 2020, this DB6 was once again assessed with a condition grade of 2 and a vehicle value of €350,000. Thanks to the excellent documentation, the mileage, maintenance history, restorations, and upgrades are all traceable. Today, the vehicle presents itself as a stylish classic in good and authentic condition, with no gaps in maintenance or pending work. A current maintenance log also details the most recent work performed on the vehicle. The DB6 remains one of the most sought-after British classics and is already looking forward to its new owner
