On June 21, 1955, this 356 was delivered to Porsche by Reutter with convertible body no. 60860. The car was finished in black R501 with wine-red Rosanil 2178 leather. After completion, the vehicle went to the USA. In 1995, the vehicle was advertised for sale as a Lady's Porsche Continental with only 79,000 miles and "first price winner" in 1989, 1990, and 1991 at the San Diego Car Show. The Porsche then returned to Europe. Here, after an initial but imperfect restoration by Harald Hackenberg, it was restored to absolute perfection and finished in its original delivery combination. The current owner has invested well over half a million euros in this Porsche. We believe that this 356 Cabriolet is the best Porsche Continental currently available on the market.
