This Porsche 911 2.7 Coupé was delivered to its first owner through the Porsche dealer Losch in Luxembourg. The original new car invoice is available. The Porsche has been regularly serviced. The original service booklet and numerous service invoices are also available. The current owner purchased the vehicle from the first owner after 31 years. The second owner immediately invested in the vehicle and had the engine and transmission overhauled. Since then, the car has covered only 11,300 kilometers. This Porsche was repainted in the rare original color Coppa Florio. This color combination is said to have been offered by the factory only twice for the SC model. This Porsche is equipped with the very rare Sportomatic transmission. The Sportomatic is a semi-automatic transmission, which means that the driver manually initiates gear changes, while the clutch is engaged automatically. This semi-automatic transmission was developed by Porsche in collaboration with the company Fichtel & Sachs.
