The Porsche 911 SC “Weissach Edition” was produced in the 1980 model year, exclusively for the U.S. market, in a limited run of 400 units. Buyers had to wait two years for their special-edition model. The Weissach Edition special models were lavishly equipped. All vehicles feature front and rear spoilers with additional fog lights in the front bumper. The equipment was complemented by Bilstein shocks, two exterior mirrors, and an electric sunroof. Additionally, 15-inch Fuchs wheels with a platinum-painted wheel center are part of the standard equipment. The exclusive interior features full leather upholstery in Doric Gray with burgundy piping and red carpets.

Originally registered in California, this rare Porsche found its way back to Germany in 2015. Here, it was meticulously restored down to the last detail by a Porsche specialist. The Porsche has been performance-tuned and features several technical upgrades. This 911 was registered in Germany in 2018. Its history over the past 45 years is well documented. There are numerous service invoices, three appraisal reports (Condition 1), and various MOT reports for the vehicle. A perfect collector’s car for the discerning Porsche enthusiast.
